| MONDAY | In GOT SPORT: Team Management bar, click on Matches, then speech bubble to corresponding match information: Message your team to remind them of: Game Date/Time (Arrive 30 minutes early for warm-up.) Game Location White jersey (Bring both to be safe) Request/confirm attendance. Hear from Away Coach. Respond to Away Coach as follows: Hi! I am the manager for (insert age group & team). We look forward to playing your team at the Northport Soccer Park on (insert date & time) on Field #. We will be wearing white as the home team. Northport Soccer Park is located on Eatons Neck Rd (Between Ocean Ave & Asharoken Ave), Northport, NY 11768. There is no specific address. | TUESDAY | Speak with your Cantera AGL if you need to borrow players. AGL should have access to team communication app and be following availability as well. |
| WEDNESDAY | Resend message to away coach if you have not heard from them. |
| THURSDAY | Hear from the referee by Thursday. Confirm match #, location, field # and time. Provide directions if prompted. Record referee contact information: name and phone number. If you have not heard from referee by noon, call referee office (LISRA) (631) 648-8877 and provide match number. |
| FRIDAY | Receive Cantera coaching assignment. Text Cantera trainer with the following information: Match # Date/Time Confirm game location Send reminder to team. |

| BRING TO GAME | 2 copies of Roster (match card) from Got Sport 1 for referee 1 for opposing team Trainer and coaches must present coaching pass. Trainer may be written onto roster. Referee fee in cash to referee in an envelope labeled as follows: Team name Match # Date/time |
| DURING GAME | Line up players for check in, in order on roster. No jewelry, cleats, shin guards, proper uniform, at attention. Make sure team is paying attention to game. Supply game ball Visitors and players are on opposite sidelines |
| AFTER GAME | Confirm score with referee. The Home team is responsible to enter the score on the day of play, please enter score by 6:00 pm. Please use pin: 0923 www.lijsoccer.com / Competitions / Coaches Enter Scores Enter Event Pin #: 0923 Match Number: Located on Game Card and Schedules |
| BAD WEATHER | Advance rain cancellations will typically be made around 6 am and notifications sent by email. If rain is forecasted, monitor your emails early on game day. Must notify other team and referee at least 2 hours prior to scheduled start of game. If cancellation occurs outside the 2-hour window, both teams MUST arrive ready to play and have game called for weather by Field Official/referee or it is considered a forfeit. Forfeit fines are automatic by the league and are assessed directly to the team/parents. Forfeit fee is \$100 plus full referee fees. If a referee suspends a match they are still to be paid in full. The home team is responsible for rescheduling the game. Follow the "Cow Harbor Rain Outs" job aide. |
| FORFEITS | Notify the following by email of forfeit: LIJSL Divisional Coordinator, LIJSL Age Group, NCHU President (president23@nchu.org) Coordinator and supervisor will notify opposing team. Forfeiting team is charged a fine of \$100. If team forfeits less than 48 hours from the match, forfeiting team pays the referee fees for both teams. |
| INJURIES | Notify your AGA and EJ Schwarz (<u>coachejs@optonline.net</u>) immediately for insurance form. Parent administrators will need to provide narrative of how and when the injury |

occurred.
